As a first response we will use Claude Bunnell's database and check with William Austin for information. We also want readers to add to the answers we provide. Please feel free to send your reply to the address at the end of the query. Please also send a copy to us so that we can share the information.

**Share the Newsletter:** We're not copyrighted, so you can share this newsletter with your local Genealogical Library or Historical Society or your family and friends. We're not a business.

**Back Issues:** Back Issues can be obtained for \$4.00 per issue, printed; that covers copying and mailing costs. #### **Web Page Update:**

I have combined these two records into 007390. Olando's parents were 020288 Joseph and Martha, so you are now back another generation. A search for local records for 020288 Joseph may yield his parentage. The website will be updated in early March with the new information. Hope this is helpful. Claude"

Gilbert M. Burr, my wife's grandfather, was for many years secretary of the Overfield Cemetery Association in Meshoppen, Wyoming co, PA. He was a meticulous, orderly sort of person, and he spent a lot of time compiling a list of all the burials which had taken place in the Cemetery previous to his appointment. From about 1908 until 1945 when he turned over the job to someone else, he added the burials as they took place. His book, which is now in my hands, includes also a map of the cemetery, a list of lot owners by lot number, and list of military veterans buried there. Following are the Bunnell family burials just as he entered them in the list. Two things should be noted: Not all information is entered - in fact, some burials I know of are missing completely. Also, there are errors which do not coincide with other available information. In a few cases, I have added data, all of which appears in *italics*. I have also added Claude Bunnell's Database number.

## Research Findings

In December I was contacted by Rose Schaer of Edwards, IL. She possessed an old abstract of title for land in Montana belonging to Walter & Rosa Bunnell in the early 1900's. She was looking for their descendents, so that she could give the abstract to them. After exchanging several e-mails, she mailed the abstract to me, with my promise that it would be discussed in the Newsletter and if descendents are found, would be passed on to them. This is the original abstract and is 67 pages long.

Here's what we know.

From the Abstract: Evidently they failed to pay the taxes on the property from 1920 through 1925 and didn't repay the loan taken out, probably to purchase the land. Rose Schaer mentions that "The whole abstract deals with Walter & Rosa's financial woes over 320 acres of property which ended up as 160 acres going to Mrs. Moll." By 1927, when the sheriff attempts to serve a summons to Walter and Rosa, they are not to be found in the county and are living in Mae, Grant County, Washington.

#### From Claude's database:

Walter Ernest Bunnell (CB018936), born 1877 in California; Parents unknown. He married, June 6, 1895 in Grangeville, Idaho County, Idaho, Rosa May Nickel who was born 1879 in Missouri. This appears to be our Walter.

Walter E. Bunnell (CB331027), born in California; parents Dennis Dowd Bunnell (320752) and(2) Martha Scott. Dennis and Martha were married in Oregon. This could also be our Walter.

So working backwards, the 1920 census shows Walter and Rosa living in Fergus Co., Montana with their daughters Gladys (ae. 22, born in Idaho) and Flora M. (ae. 16 and born in Idaho). He is a

bookkeeper in a bank. He states his birthplace as California, but for his parents lists only "United States." He is 42 years old; therefore born about 1878.

The 1910 census shows them living in Grangeville; his father being born in NY and mother in NL; he was a bookkeeper in a bank and they have two daughters, Gladys 14 and Flora 6. He states that he was born in California, his father in New York, but has no entry for his mother's place of birth. He is 31 years old; therefore born about 1879.

The 1880 census for the United States has one Walter Bunnell who was born in California. This one is living in Washington Territory, Columbia Co, Town of Dayton. He was born abt. 1875 (5 years old in 1880 census), in California. He is the son of D.D. and Martha Bunnell. D.D would be Dennis Dowd Bunnell.

I can find none of the family in the 1930 census and we have no info on whether the daughters married and have descendents.

I contacted Claude and told him I believe that Walter Ernest Bunnell (CB018936) and Walter E. Bunnell (CB331027) are the same person, the Walter E. in the abstract, and the son of Dennis and Martha Bunnell. He was born in the right place and is the only Walter Bunnell who was. The birth year is off by about 2-3 years and I have no explanation for that. Claude agrees and is merging the two Walters.

William Austin checked his records and responded as follows: 'You are correct that Walter Ernest Bunnell was the son of Dennis Dowd Bunnell. I dug into my files for the following corroborative evidence:

First, In 1969 Mrs. Zoe Magden sent me a copy of Dennis Dowd Bunnell's obituary in the Lewiston, ID, newspaper. Here is an extract: "He has three living children, Ida, Oscar, and Walter. The former is married and lives in Chico, California, and her husband is one of the proprietors of the Chronicle. Oscar is married and with his family lives here. Walter is but a lad and lives here with his uncle," The uncle, of course, was Charles C. Bunnell 320753.

Second, Mrs. Magden sent her book of Bunnell notes to Ruth Duncan, who copied them for her own files, which she later sent to me. In them I find an abstract from the Office of Probate Judge, Lewiston, Nez Perce Co. Idaho, Case 952. "Charles C. Bunnell died 17 April 1908 made his will May 22, 1901. Will filed for probate 18 May 1908 left large estate, about 40,000 free from debt." Charles C. was aged 65 on May 22, 1901. Entire estate devised to wife Flora A. Other specified heirs: Oscar C. Bunnell, Mrs. J. S. Vincent of Kendrick, Idaho; Mrs. George H. Lake, Lewiston, Idaho; Walter Bunnell, Grangeville, Ida; Mrs. W. W. Brown, Grangeville, Ida; Mrs. Ida Thompson, Lewiston, Ida; to each 1/6 of remainder after death of wife Flora A."

There you have it. Dennis's son Walter went to live with his uncle Charles after his father died, and Charles left 1/6 of his estate to Walter Bunnell of Grangeville, ID. I think that constitutes sufficient proof that the two Walters were the same person. I have no further info on Walter's daughters.'

So, Walter's lineage is: Walter<sup>8</sup>, Dennis<sup>7</sup>, Dennis<sup>6</sup>, Israel<sup>5</sup>, Ebenezer<sup>4</sup>, Nathaniel<sup>3</sup>, Benjamin<sup>2</sup>, William<sup>1</sup>. But, we are still left without any descendants for Walter and Rosa beyond their daughters. Has anyone out there pursued that line?

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Carol Brotzman requested information about two James Bunnells. She is trying to find the parents of James I Bunnell and James Israel Bunnell, and are they the same person?

James Israel Bunnell married Harriet Squiers.

Issue:

Charles Ralph Bunnell, b. 10 April 1884.

**James I Bunnell** was born 1850 in WI. He married Alice L Potter 4 October 1873 in Skinners Eddy [PA] Church marriage listing, daughter of Riley Potter and Lorania Palmer.

Issue:

Nettie, b. abt 1879; Riley, b. abt 1880.

After reviewing her material and looking through Claude's database at James I Bunnell (330649), I was ready to conclude that they are the same person. But when trying to confirm her census reference and the one cited in the data base (1860 census, Smithville, NY, R0734-F0509-p0102) I couldn't find the data base reference. When I go to the cited page I find Edward Bunnel (head), but "Jane" rather than "James" is listed as a ten year old. The only son of Edward listed is Rufus, age 5. I believed that her two James Bunnells are the same person, but was not so sure they are the son of Edward. I asked Claude for his thoughts.

He responded: "About the ancestry of 330649 James I. Bunnell. I came to the conclusion that linkage was an error and have unlinked him. His number now is 033833. The change will appear in the next update of the web site. I looked at all the Bunnell families in Wisconsin in the 1850 census but did not find one that had a later son named James. There was listed some Census records dated 1854 and 1855. I have sent for information on how I can view these records. It appears James married his first wife Alice Potter in Skinners Eddy, Wyoming Co, PA. I wonder if anyone has a copy of the marriage record to see if it listed his parents. I feel confident we will find his ancestry eventually."

Then, just before finishing this article for the Newsletter, I decided to do a quick search of census data and the 1900 census shows James I Bunnell (b. 1850), wife Mary (b. 1838), and a son, Charles R. (b. 1884) living in Springville, Susquehanna Co., PA. James and Mary have been married 5 years and James was born in Wisconsin, father's birthplace unknown, and mother born in England. Very close to the information for both of Carol's James. This would indicate that, if there is one James, he was married three times, or perhaps I should say at least three times.

So while we don't have proof the three James are in fact one or two, there are enough similarities to suggest they are one. Anyone with further info is invited to send it in.

Regarding the weavers cited on page 48 of the November 2003 Newsletter: 330101 Ellen, 330095 Salina & 330102 Martha. [Ed: Ellen<sup>8</sup>, Salmon<sup>7</sup>, Havilah<sup>6</sup>, Noah<sup>5</sup>, Gershom<sup>4</sup>, Benjamin<sup>3</sup>, Benjamin<sup>2</sup>, William<sup>1</sup>; Salina<sup>8</sup>, Hiram<sup>7</sup>, Havilah<sup>6</sup>, then same as Ellen; Martha<sup>8</sup>, Salmon<sup>7</sup>, Havilah<sup>6</sup>, then same as Ellen. So it appears that 2 sisters and a cousin were boarding and working together.]

Regarding Harriet Bunnell on page 54 of the November 2003 Newsletter: Harriet Bunnell is memb # 027505. I have several notes on her. She married Joshua Woodbury Peck; however I do not know her parentage.

I have just completed adding all the 1910 census listings to the db and will update the web site about the end of Feb. Now I will concentrate on the 1930 census.

## Misinformation

We've all run across data that we knew was of questionable accuracy, and often you've asked the other subscribers, William Austin, or Claude Bunnell for help in sorting it out. I don't believe that any of us would purposely publish erroneous data. Not all researchers seem to feel the same way however. Making the problem worse is the ease and speed with which bad information can be spread, thanks to the internet. And some websites provide neither sources for the data nor a means of contacting the contributing author. Familysearch.org, the LDS website, is unfortunately one of those sites for many of the listings they provide.

The most recent example of misinformation, or perhaps even disinformation, was brought to my attention by Cecil Bunnell. On the Family Search website, using the search function in the IGI for North America, you will find a listing stating that William Bunnell was born in 1610 in New Haven, CT, a Native American of the Mohegan Tribe. It shows Ann Wilmot born in 1614, also a member of the Mohegan Tribe. Needless to say, this goes against all of the research all of us have done. I can't imagine why anyone would make such a claim unless they're trying to prove Native American ancestry for some financial gain (Start their own casino perhaps?). William Austin, when I contacted him about this, provided an excellent response and I want to share it with everyone.

"Hi, Charlie -

This is the sort of thing that gives genealogy a bad name. I suppose I should laugh about it, but I have spent so much time and effort in trying to scotch the many errors that simply won't die that I can't find anything funny about a new one. This is pure fabrication, without any basis at all. Please review the contemporary documentation which is all printed in Newsletter #2 (and in my book), and you will see there why we know that this is nonsense. There was no settlement in New Haven until 1639, and William Bunnell was not a part of it then. He did not appear there until he returned from England in the very late 1640s. Previous to 1646 all the references to him show that he lived in the Massachusetts Bay Colony. Probably he was married there, tho that may have occurred in England. Certainly it wasn't in Wallingford; his grandson Nathaniel was the first Bunnell to move to Wallingford about 1712 as one of the early settlers there. The friends in England that William spoke of in 1654 who would take care of him there would have been surprised to hear that he was a Mohegan Indian!

If you put this in the Newsletter I hope that you take a firm position that this is proven false, so that no one will be able to cite the Newsletter as a source of this "information"

As far as I'm concerned, even with the disclaimers that the website provides, publishing (that's what they are doing) such claims as this without providing a means to contact the author isn't right. In the April 1988 issue of the Newsletter, there was a discussion on the validity of IGI information and the source of the IGI. To paraphrase William Austin's warning at that time: Most of the data in the IGI is from unproven family sheets provided by individuals. To me, that makes the entire data suspect unless you are given the primary source.
