My name is Donna Samuel (nee Williams). I was born in Australia. I'm the granddaughter of Henry Roy Bonnell. He was the son of James Henry Bonnell born in 1856. James Henry Bonnell was the son of James Bonnell d.o.b unknown but we can assume he was born no earlier than 1816 and no later than 1836.

This is where our trail runs cold. The father of James Bonnell would have been born somewhere in the range 1776-1816 and would have had to have migrated to Australia some time in the range 1777-1836. I discovered your Bonnell site and my father told me he believed his father (Henry Roy) may have descended from American Bonnells. I have reviewed ALL the Bonnell men born in that age range for whom there is no year of death given, assuming that either these men were 1) missing 2) the death had not been registered 3) no record of death has been found or 4) they migrated. There are only 3 possible US Bonnells who could have been my great great great grandfather and the father of James Bonnell. These are:

James Hervey Bonnell, son of Sylvanus and Nancy Bonnell (cousins), born 1811

John Wichliff Bonnell, son of Sylvanus and Nancy Bonnell (cousins), born 1812

William Bonnell, son of John and Nancy Farrady, born 1788

I answered her e-mail with some info from Claude's database. But her response dashed my hopes of cementing an American~Australian connection:

Hi there Charlie and Pat.

We traced our end back to James Bonnell in Victoria 1845, married to Charlotte. He was a publican in Collingwood, Victoria. A James Bonnell convict was transported 1820 on Mangles 1, from UK to NSW, served 17 years, married Charlotte Brown in 1837 and was freed in 1837. There is a record relating this one to Collingwood and its fairly like the convict James Bonnell is our guy.

So this would place me as the great great granddaughter of a UK convict James Bonnell. He had several brothers, including Charles, who also became a convict sent to NSW, plus siblings, George, Henry, Roy and Mary. I've found a UK contact who has traced them back from there.

Thanks so much for exhausting the possible US connection. But seems I descend from the UK lot.

I hope you don't mind me dropping you a line. I've just happened on your site, which I must admit I haven't read fully yet (sorry!) - but I thought I would let you know about this Bonnell.

My full name is Peter Richard Bonnell, and I was born in Liverpool in '73. I now live in the South of the UK. I also lived in Fayetteville, Arkansas for three years.

I thought I would write as Bonnell is such an unusual name in the UK - in fact, all of the people living in the North-west of England that I know of are related to me. One thing - my aunt (who married a Bonnell) did some research into our family tree, and believes that we are related to a Sir David Bonnell who, I think, lived in the 15th or 16th Century.

I'd be quite interested in looking into my family tree, and was wondering if your ancestors are in any way related to mine?

I basically told Peter that it was not possible with this amount of info to determine if there was a direct relationship and filled him in on the Bonnell and Bunnell immigrants that we are aware of. I also told him that I was not able to find any info using Google on the Sir David Bonnell he mentioned. I asked him for any of his lineage that he did know and suggested that he interview any/all of the oldest members of the family as soon as possible (don't we all wish we had done that!). His response was:

I'm afraid a lot of the older members of my dad's family have passed on. In fact, my grandfather - Reginald Bonnell - passed away in 1965, 8 years before I was born. My Nan (grandmother) - Lucy Bonnell (nee Clarke) passed in 1986. My dad still lives near Liverpool, but has been very unwell of late (his name is Francis Bonnell). I'll talk some more to him, to see if I can get any leads.

We had one more brief exchange on the Bonnell coat of arms and that was it. Until he can trace his line back or we all engage in some DNA testing, that's probably about all we can do.

Cecil Bunnell, [cecilanna@clarityconnect.com](mailto:cecilanna@clarityconnect.com), or 1843 State Route 34, Genoa, NY 13071-9707 invited us to look at a new or newly found website: <http://www.colonialct.uconn.edu/default.cfm>. The site is titled "Colonial Connecticut Records, 1636-1776" and in a box on the left it states: "The Public Records of the Colony of Connecticut, 1636-1776." It is not the most user-friendly site I've seen; for example you can't search all of the records at once by surname. But the records are divided up by time periods and then you can search by name within each time period. I searched the first three volumes (April 1636-April 1665, May 1665- Nov 1677, May 1678-Jun 1689) and could not find any Bunnells/Bonnells in any of the various spelling variations. None the less it is interesting reading and also presents some insight into the laws and mores of the time. If you use the internet you might take a look at this site.

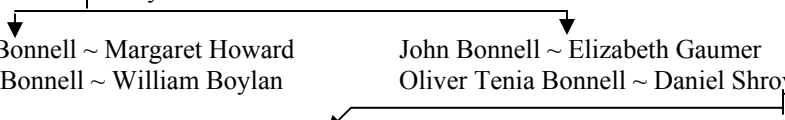

Clarice Bonnell Anderson was the daughter of Charles and Maude (Jett) Anderson of Kentucky. Charles A. came to the USA at the age of 15 from Sweden. Maude Jett's family was of Wickcliff, Kentucky.

Bonnell Slapak was born "at West Suburban Hospital", no doubt Chicago area. Her mid-August, 2005 obit. reads "Bonnell L. Knoch, 81. nee Slapak, beloved wife of the late Fred W." Both the Andersons and Fred & Bonnell S. Knoch lived in Oak Park many years, Oak Park being a suburb of Chicago.

Jerry spoke via telephone with the brother of Bonnell L. Slapak. Unfortunately he does not know the origin of the name "Bonnell" in the family. Jerry also said that the name could have been that of a neighbor, God-parents, etc., who knows?? Robert Bonnell was born in 1675. He married (1) 4 Aug 1699, at the House of Eliakim Wardell of Quaker Meeting in Shrewsbury, Monmouth co, NJ, Esther Wardell, b. 167?, d. prob. before 1707); (2) 16 Oct 1707, Philadelphia, PA, Frances Chanders Goodwin b.167?, d. 1750 in Burlington co., NJ. Issue (all of wife 2): Thomas (170?-?), Hannah (171?-1754), John (171?-?), Samuel (1721-1767).

Robert may have been from New Jersey as his first marriage took place there in Monmouth county. Though he moved back to New Jersey from Philadelphia about 1721, the area he moved to, Gloucester co, is directly across the Delaware River from Philadelphia. While his first marriage took place in Monmouth co, it doesn't appear likely that he descended from Nathaniel Bonnell, of Monmouth co. and son of the immigrant William, unless Nathaniel had another, up-to-now unknown, son. Also, Robert was a Quaker, which is not common to that line.

Robert was mentioned in the last issue where his 2<sup>nd</sup> marriage, to Frances Chanders Godwin, was reported under Research Findings.

### Frank Charles Bunnell

Birth: Mar. 9, 1842

Death: Sep. 11, 1911

Civil War Veteran US Congressman. He enlisted in the 52nd Pennsylvania Volunteer Infantry, and was mustered in as a Sergeant in Company B on September 20, 1861. On March 1, 1862 he was promoted to Quartermaster Sergeant of the regiment, a duty he performed until he was discharged due to disability on April 2, 1863. He became a successful banker, and made an unsuccessful Congressional run in 1872. However, late that year Congressman Ulysses Mercer resigned his seat to become a Pennsylvania Supreme Court Justice, and Frank Bunnell was appointed to fill the vacancy. He represented Pennsylvania's 13th District in the United States House of Representatives, serving from December 14, 1872 to March 3, 1873, when the duly-elected Congressman James Dale Strawbridge was sworn in. Returning home, he served in local political offices until 1884, when he was elected was a Republican to represent Pennsylvania's 15th District in the United States House of Representatives. He served from March 4, 1884 to March 3, 1888, and did not run again for election after serving two terms (his seat was subsequently filled by Congressman Myron Benjamin Wright). He passes away in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 1911 at the age of 69.

**DNA:** Several months ago Donna Doscher, [donnaad@bellsouth.net](mailto:donnaad@bellsouth.net), or 102 Primrose Path, Summerville, SC 29483 wrote that she'd had her DNA tested and that it showed that she had Native American ancestry. I suggested to her at the time that it might be on her father's side (her mother was a Bunnell) as we weren't aware of any NA in the Bunnell line. Then in December she wrote that her cousin, her mother's brother's son and a Bunnell, had his DNA test and it reported that his father's side (The Bunnell line) is strictly Northern European. Thus the NA is on Donna's father's side.

The December issue of the National Genealogical Society Quarterly was devoted strictly to Genealogy and Genetics – DNA. While some of the articles become a little difficult to decipher, overall I learned a lot from them. Finally, the February 2<sup>nd</sup> issue of USA Today had a ¾ page spread on the use of DNA to determine genealogical lineage, though it focused primarily on the use of the test for African-Americans to trace their lineage beyond their slave ancestors.

From what I've read up to this point I see some potential good if the Bunnell/Bonnell family becomes involved in DNA Testing. I plan to have an article on the use of DNA for genealogical purposes ready for the next issue. But some of you, besides Donna, may already be familiar with the process and the outcomes.
