

Gale Storm, 87, Is Dead; Earned Television Fame for Her Wholesome Roles

Gale Storm, the Texas-born actress who made wholesome perkiness a defining element of television's golden age on two hit sitcoms, "My Little Margie" and "The Gale Storm Show," died Saturday at a convalescent hospital in Danville, Calif., according to a representative of the hospital. She was 87.

Ms. Storm had been a B-movie actress for more than a decade when "My Little Margie" had its premiere on CBS in June 1952 as a summer replacement for the era's biggest hit series, "I Love Lucy." Ms. Storm played a young Manhattanite living with her widowed father (Charles Farrell), an affluent businessman, and often trying to keep amorous single women away from him. Critics dismissed the show as silly, but the public disagreed and the series ran for three full seasons.

After her decade of television fame, Ms. Storm turned to stage work in Las Vegas and to regional theater. But she also battled alcoholism in the 1970s and wrote about her struggle in her 1981 autobiography, "I Ain't Down Yet."

"I was the star of my own cornball B movie," she wrote, alluding to her success and her stable, happy home life, "and suddenly it turned into a horror story." She gave the credit for her recovery to a California hospital's aversion-therapy program.

Josephine Owaissa Cottle was born on April 5, 1922, in Bloomington, Tex., a small town near the Gulf of Mexico. She was the youngest of five children (an older sister suggested her middle name, an American Indian word for bluebird). Her father, a potter, died when Josephine was a year old, and her mother became a seamstress to make ends meet.

The family moved to Houston, where Josephine was active in high school dramatics. Two teachers there persuaded her to enter the Gateway to Hollywood talent contest, sponsored by the producer Jesse L. Lasky, RKO Radio Pictures and Wrigley, the chewing gum manufacturer.

In 1939 she won the local competition and traveled with her mother to Hollywood, where she won the national prize, which included the preordained screen name Gale Storm and an RKO contract. In a fairy tale twist, she also met and fell in love with the contest's male winner, Lee Bonnell, a young actor from Indiana. She married him in 1941.

Ms. Storm's marriage to Mr. Bonnell, who abandoned his acting career early on and became an insurance executive, lasted until his death in 1986. They had four children. In 1988 she married Paul Masterson, a former ABC television executive, who died in 1996.

She is survived by three sons, Phillip, Peter and Paul; a daughter, Susie; eight grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.

Queries

In the last issue, page 54 had a short bio of Rufus P. Bunnell from *Binghamton [NY]; Its Settlement, Growth and Development, 1800-1900* which mentioned that Rufus left for California after graduation from Eastman's Business College in 1875. He later returned to Broome county and in 1885 married Nettie Parsons. Claude's site did not mention the California trip. On a whim I decided to check the California census for 1880 and see if Rufus was still in California at that time. Sure enough he is San Francisco but the census shows him as married to 17 year old Marryen [maybe, Maryann?] and Rufus is a streetcar driver. Neither the marriage nor the job was mentioned in the bio. However the census also shows that he had been unemployed for two months of the year, so the conductor job may have been a temporary until he was hired into one of the positions mentioned in the bio. Marryen and her parents were all born in PA. But I have not been able to find out any more information.

Rufus can't be found in the 1870 census when he would be 15 years old. His mother had died in 1863 and his father remarried two years later to Deborah King. But before the 1870 census was taken, his father had already died. His step-mother was living with her King family members in Susquehanna county, PA.

The next step I believe is to search the local county records for marriages, deaths, and divorces in Broome and Chenango counties, NY, Susquehanna county, PA and San Francisco county, CA. None of the sites for those counties on the internet provided any information. We probably need a courthouse and old newspaper search. If anyone is able to check out those counties' records we'd sure appreciate the help.

In the February 2008 edition of the newsletter we carried a query from Carol Perry, <a href="littmen31@sbcglobal.net">littmen31@sbcglobal.net</a> seeking the parentage of Charity Bonnell, wife of Barnet Bonnell (CB310259). By most accounts she was the daughter of Simeon and Mary (Slaght) Dickerson. However Carol pointed out several facts that called that into question. In May of this year she posted the following on the Rootsweb Bonnell Message Board:

#### Charlie,

I am happy to report that my quandary over the true identity of Barnett Bunnell's wife has been resolved. My initial search not leading to a solution, I dropped the matter for several months and only recently decided to take another look.

As I suspected, Charity, dau. of Simeon and Mary (Slaght) DICKERSON was not Barnett's wife. His wife was Charity DICKISSON, alias DICKINSON, dau. of Pvt. Isaac and Margaret (Parker) DICKISSON, born abt.1799 in New Jersey, died sometime after the U.S. Census of 1850 and before that of 1860. Definitive proof of her identity was found in the Revolutionary War Pension Records of Isaac Dickisson in a document by James E. Eldred, Clerk of the Orphans Court of Pike County, PA in which he certifies that '...Charity Dickinson formerly wife of Barnett Bunnell...' [a copy of the document is available for \$2.95 at <a href="www.footnote.com/image/19230843">www.footnote.com/image/19230843</a>].

I received the following e-mail from Anita Emberlin, aeberlin@texhoma.net] with a subject of: "Bunnell from Illinois to Canada in 1890-1904." I was not able to help her and offered to put this in the newsletter.

Seeking information on a set of surnames that link Hamilton Co., Ohio to Illinois then Yellow Grass, Sask., Canada.

The Bunnell family with Pat and wife Elizabeth left Illinois and went to Yellow Grass, Sask, Canada in 1910 to live on his brother Orville Bunnell's farm/ranch. Later another brother, Orin Bunnell and family joined the other brothers in the same area. Orin died in the 1918 flu season, then his widow and sons Raymond and Harold returned to Windon, Missouri.

Pat died in 1967; his wife Elizabeth passed away in 1977, age 91.

Somehow these Bunnell brothers were a cousin to James W. Boren who lived in 1900 Barton Co., MO with parents William R. Boren and his wife, Aurora Hendricks Boren. James W. Boren married Birdie Rebecca (unknown surname) and moved her and his daughter Eula and son William to Yellow Grass in 1906.

I am trying to find how the Bunnell and James W. Boren are related. On the Boren side or the Hendricks side (Aurora was a daughter of John Hendricks and his wife Charlotte Gardner; Charlotte Gardner was born in Hamilton Co., Ohio).

Do you have any input on this cousin connection between Boren and Bunnell?

Biographies

From *History of Buchanan County Iowa And Its People*, Vol. II, The S. J. Clarke Publishing Company, 1914; Pages 331-332:

Mrs. Joseph Bunnell

Mrs. Joseph Bunnell, who makes her home on a farm in Jefferson township, has continuously resided in this county during the past thirty-six years and is well known and highly esteemed throughout the community. She was born in New York on the 1st of July, 1839, and on the 3d of October, 1860, gave her hand in marriage to Joseph Bunnell whose natal day was April 15, 1835. The young couple established their home in Indiana immediately following their marriage, and in that state Mr. Bunnell engaged in the milling business, operating a flour and sawmill with the turning lathe attachment. Mrs. Bunnell still has two chairs that wee made by him at that time. In 1864, during the gold excitement then raging in Idaho, he and others started for the west, going by rail to the end of the road, which was at Grinnell, Iowa, and then across the plains by ox teams and covered wagons. He remained in the west for two years and at the end of that time returned to Indiana, where he was engaged in the hardware business until 1873.

That year witnessed the arrival of Mr. Bunnell and his family in Iowa and for about five years they made their home upon a farm in Black Hawk county, but in 1878 became residents of Buchanan county, purchasing a tract of land in Jefferson township. Mr. Bunnell won prosperity in the conduct of his farming interests and became widely recognized as a substantial farmer and a respected citizen. He passed away on the 30th of July, 1911, at the age of seventy-six years.

For over a half century he and his wife had traveled life's journey together and on the 3d of October, 1910 celebrated their golden wedding, at which time their children and grandchildren were all present. Their children are: Mrs. O. M. Kinney, H. S. and B. B. Since the father's death the last named has operated the home farm and is meeting with good success in its cultivation. He was married on the 25th of December, 1895, to Miss Grace Standish, and they have four children, Miles Standish, Floyd B., Clarence J. and Sarah B. The family is one of prominence in the community where they reside and are held in high esteem by all who know them. Although not a member of any religious denomination, Mrs. Bunnell is a firm believer in the Bible and her life has ever been in harmony with its teachings.

From Biographical History of Northeastern Ohio Embracing the Counties of Ashtabula, Trumbull and Mahoning, The Lewis Publishing Company; 1893; Pages 606 through 608:

Henry O. Bonnell. - Henry O. Bonnell, president of the Mahoning National Bank, president of the Mahoning Valley Iron Company, president of the Hubbard Rolling Mill Company, president of the Mahoning and Shenango [sic] Valley Manufacturing Association, chairman of the Youngstown Coke Company, director in the Ohio Steel Company, director in the Lakeside Nail Company, of Hammond, Indiana, and director in the First national Bank, now deceased, was born at New Lay, Yorkshire, England, January 11, 1839, a son of William and Sarah A. (Scott) Bonnell, both natives of England. Our subject being the eldest son of the family of eight children born to Mr. and Mrs. Bonnell, his assistance was required at home in the mill, office and elsewhere, and consequently his educational advantages were limited to the instruction to be gained at the country schools, supplemented by one term at the Youngstown school, after which he entered his father's mill and proceeded to learn lessons in the school of experience of the practical side of life, which were to fit

him for the successful management of his own affairs in after life. So proficient did he prove himself that later he was promoted to the position of bookkeeper in the office, and still later to that of paymaster.

Upon the death of his father in 1875, the association of Brown, Bonnell & Company was incorporated, with Henry O. Bonnell as vice president, which position he so able filled that he was re-elected to it successively until 1879, when the company disposed of its interests to other parties, although the same name was retained. In 1879, Messrs. H. O. Bonnell, Richard Brown, C. D. Arms, W. Scott Bonnell and others purchased the Valley Mill plant on Crab creek, and began operating it under the firm name of Mahoning Valley Iron Company, H. O. Bonnell then being the senior member of the house. Upon the incorporation of the company in 1886, Henry O. Bonnell was elected the president, which position he filled most ably until the time of his death, combining with the duties of president those of manager also; and to his energy and enterprise much of the present prosperity of the company is due. He was an untiring worker and to his energy and sagacity is due much of the prominence of Youngstown as an iron center. Beginning at the bottom of the ladder of fortune, by his own efforts he rose to the top rung, rising from a partner in the Mahoning Valley Iron Company in 1867, to its president in 1886.

Mr. Bonnell was married in October, 1870, to Miss Mary Julia Botsford, daughter of Archibald Grant and Eliza (Byrne) Botsford, of Youngstown, and their marriage has been blessed with the birth of four children, namely: Mary, Elida Floyd, Henry Scott and Isabel. Henry Scott died, March 2, 1886, in New York city, from fatal injuries received while the family were visiting in that city, his age then being seven years and nine months.

Mr. Bonnell was a most thorough and energetic business man, a perfect gentleman and one who is well known and highly respected by all with whom he came in contact. He was generous in thought, prompt in action, and combined with an easy adaptability to circumstances a pleasing presence which highly commended him to the kind consideration of those with whom he had either social or business relations. His name has always been a synonym for untiring business energy, untarnished honor and unblemished integrity. Overwork and unremitting attention to the vast details which he assumed as executive head of a great business were the remote cause of his death. his career being suddenly closed in the midst of his strength and usefulness. The immediate cause was attributed to heart trouble, which produced pulmonary affection, and he died, January 16, 1893, a steadfast member of the Episcopal Church of Youngstown, with which both he and his wife had been connected for many years. Throughout the entire country Mr. Bonnell's death was noticed in periodicals, newspapers and trade journals, his demise being regarded as almost a national calamity, so prominent was he, and so well beloved. His usefulness was so far-reaching, his goodness of heart so infinite, and his talents so remarkable that his loss seemed a personal one to thousands of people throughout Mahoning valley and other localities, their grief being second only to that of those who are connected with him by their endearing ties of husband, father, brother and friend. His life was filled to the brim with usefulness, and for the last twenty years he has been one of the central figures in the Mahoning valley. Although conservative in politics he was a progressive man when he believed the proposed advancement was for the best interests of the country. Owing to his superior mental attainments Mr. Bonnell was enabled to weigh and consider projects and measures with deliberation, and acted upon his decisions with a determination which not only achieved success but which also won for him the admiration of all his co-laborers. His disposition was a cheerful one, and he was always ready and willing to lend his aid to any less fortunate person, while his public-spirited ideas prompted him in advancing all measures tending toward the betterment of the material welfare of the city. The best in literature he read, the finest in art he admired and in religion he clung to all that was pure, lovable and holy, dying a firm believer in the faith in which he lived so noble and upright a life. Mr. Bonnell's memory will live in the hearts of the people of the Mahoning valley long after that of less important personages shall have passed away, and his name will be handed down to future generations as a synonym of all that is good, pure and upright.



We have started another immigrant line and hope to determine the DNA values for that immigrant as more descendants participate in the DNA program. Steven Bonnell, slbnl@KBSB.com or 1523 Good Shepherd Road, Montoursville, PA 17754, has DNA values that are significantly different from the William Bunnell line. He has traced his line back to John Bonnell, 004113. We now have a total of 3 descendants of that John who have participated in the DNA testing and it appears that we have the start of another baseline. Steve recently obtained *The Bonnell Genealogy*, by Sara Rebecca E. Spang, published by Mary Jamieson, 1992. On Page 32 it states that the progenitor of this line, John Bonnell, was born in Dublin, Ireland and married his wife, Nancy Farraday or Pandry there, emigrating from Dublin in 1774. She doesn't provide a source for that statement. However, I also

received from Beverly Vaughn, <u>blvaughn@bresnan.net</u>, a copy of a letter written in 1952 by Margaret Bonnell (009220), a descendant of John Bonnell, stating that her mother said "old grandpa Bonnell talked so 'Irishy' that she could not understand him." Specifically which "old grandpa" she was referring to isn't clear, but it certainly adds to the argument that there is an Irish background in this branch. These two sources plus the DNA mismatch with the William line, convinces me that this line should be disconnected from William and Betsy (Parrody) Bunnell (027429). Of course this also now extends the search to Ireland. Might he be a descendant of the famous Thomas Bonnell, a Huguenot refugee who settled in Norwich, England, where he died in 1607? This is the Thomas Bonnell that so many researchers have tried, unconvincingly, to tie to the immigrant William. It would be almost ironic if that proved out.

Post Script
