**Submitting items for the newsletter:** To help us keep track of the material, please include your name, address and date on each piece of paper you submit, including photos. For newspaper articles, including obituaries, please include the name of the paper it came from to include the date, city, state and page number. If you have the capability to send in your item electronically, as an attachment to your e-mail, that's great. But we'll accept it in any format, **so send it in!**

**2006 Dues:** It doesn't seem possible, but the 2006 newsletter donations are due in January. As many of you know we actually look for the payment sometime during the first 3 months of the year. The February issue will go out to all current subscribers and then we'll begin pleading in earnest. There's no change in the amount. So once you get through the holiday period think about sending us the check, made out to Charles Bunnell. If you've already paid for 2006, ignore this paragraph. The date you are paid through is on the address label for those who receive the printed newsletter. For the electronic subscribers, we'll be notifying you in February of your "paid through" date.

**Back Issues:** Printed back Issues can be obtained for \$4.00 per copy. That covers copying and mailing costs. We have electronic versions of several back issues which are available to members free on the web.

**Web Page Update:** Big changes on the web site.

First, "Public Pages" is no longer a separate page. Instead, it is a drop-down menu on the left side of each page. Just roll over "Public Pages" and your choices will show up.

Secondly, there are more public pages to view and have your material displayed on. We built an "Unattached Branches" page where we can list those Bunnells/Bonnells that we can't fit to the tree. So now all unattached branches will be in the Newsletter and on the web for the entire world to see. Your name, address or e-mail address won't have to be there; we'll just have ours there and will forward meaningful contacts to you.


Sort of in concert with the Unattached Branches, we've added an "Unidentified Fotos" page where you can post your old photos that contain, or probably contain, unidentified Bunnells/Bonnells. Send your photos, either by e-mail or regular mail, and we'll add them to the page. As with the "Unattached Branches," your name, etc doesn't have to show up on the web page.

Finally, we've built a Family Fotos page that will display old (at least 50 years) photos of Bunnells and Bonnells who we can tell a little bit about. So send your photos in with a brief write-up. It's easier if you can e-mail an electronic copy, but we'll also accept mailed copies.

## Correspondence

William Tidball, 28 - 9600 Turner St., Summerland BC V0H 1Z5, Canada, wrote that he had driven in the area of WV we highlighted in the last issue: Bunnell's Run, Pennsboro, WV. Bill mentioned that there was also a "Bunnell Run outside Harrisville, WV which is a few miles east of Pennsboro. Looking at the Mapquest maps of the area, it appears that Bunnell Run flows between Pennsboro and Harrisville, so I believe there is just one. Bill also sent along a photo of the West Virginia historical marker. I've added this photo to the Landmarks page on the website.

Then Clem Bonnell, [cabonnell@worldnet.att.net](mailto:cabonnell@worldnet.att.net), or 7 Deer Path, Milford, NJ 08848-1928 called to tell me that the John Bunnell in the "History of Ritchie County" and cited on the historical marker is actually John Bonnell, 310033 in Claude's database. Bill Austin originally ran an article on him in Vol. VIII, page 34. John ended up in Harrison co, WV after leaving the Pennsboro area. Harrison co. was formed in 1784 and Ritchie co. was formed in 1843 from Harrison, Lewis, Wood counties. So he may not have moved far. There are many Bunnells and Bonnells in Harrison co. in the 1930 census. So the mystery of who John Bunnell is has been solved ... again.

\*A really interesting example of a “stone wall” that future genealogists would run into when researching this lineage. She wrote that: “My grandmother and grandfather Robert and Frances (Bunnell) Reed] divorced and she eventually remarried a man named (James, I think) Stephens. But all her children (she had 4 boys and 1 girl) were from her marriage to Robert Reed. However, shortly after my father and mother were married (he was 17years old and a minor), my grandmother had all the children's last name legally changed to Stephens, even my Mom and Dad's. So they were married as Mr. & Mrs. Robert James Reed and then their name was changed a few months later to Mr. & Mrs. Robert J. Stephens.”

Note: "William Erwin of the Bible record, married Susanna Curry, daughter of James Curry of Augusta Co., Virginia, 4 July 1785. This couple came to Green Co., Kentucky in 1803, at least William Erwin was on the Green County Tax Roll for the year 1803. This Bible was given to Susanna Erwin, born Oct 5, 1793, who married in Green Co., Ky., June 19, 1810, to one Peter Bunnell (Bunnell). Peter and Susannah lived in Green County until about 1835, when they moved to Hart County. I have a great deal of data re: Bunnell, and would be glad to exchange with others working on this line. Peter Bunnell (1) was born January 15, 1784. I have no idea where he came from before showing up in Green Co., in 1810. I rather think that he was in Mercer County, but have no real proof." Children Nancy through Louisa are the children of Peter and Susanna (Erwin) Bunnell. As I promised last issue on page 43, here is the rest of the story about Carl Edward Bonnell, 342457 in Claude's database. This was provided by Don and Joyce Sage, [dsage@usfamily.net](mailto:dsage@usfamily.net), or 2925 Lincoln Drive, Apt. #318, Roseville, MN 53113-1347.

Carl told the story of when they immigrated to Minnesota from Assumption, Illinois by railroad, that he and his brothers rode in the same boxcar that contained their livestock (horses and cows) and belongings. Their father, Edmond Stanton Bonnell, in search of good choice farm land at a low price, had gone on railroad farm land promotion excursions up into the Dakotas, but he found the best deal in Jackson County, MN and settled on a 640 acre section near Miloma, MN.

His father was born in Norfolk, Va., and his mother was a native of North Carolina. The father died April 20, 1853, and the mother died December 22, 1880. Our subject enlisted in the war April 1861, going out with Capt. Bonment's Artillery, Company A, and was afterward transferred to the Fiftieth Tennessee Infantry. Falling ill with the measles, he was sent to the hospital, and upon recovering joined Company I, Eleventh Tennessee Regiment, and took part in all the hard fought battles of that regiment. At the battle of Franklin, he was wounded three different times, and was sent to the hospital. Returning home after the war, he was married, February 15, 1872, to **Elenora C. Blake**, who was born August 5, 1850, in Humphreys County, Tenn., she being the daughter of **Martin W. and Jane Simpson**. To them have been born the following children: **Claud**, born July 20, 1873; **Maud W.**, born March 25, 1875; **Daisy E.**, born May 15, 1877; **James B.**, born April 30, 1879; **Samuel A.**, born April 8, 1881, and **Hart**, born June 16, 1883, and died October 16, 1884. Mr. Bunnell is a member of the Masonic fraternity, is a Democrat and stands well in his community.

[Ed Note: Theodore Bunnell is #005784 in Claude's data base. His lineage is only known back to his father, shown as John in Claude's data base. This adds data to what is available in Claude's data base; specifically date of John/James Bunnell's death, the last name for his wife Susan/Sarah, and her original home as North Carolina. Note that not all of Theodore's children are listed in the article as they were born after the publication of the book.]

**Benjamin Trotter** was born on Barton's Creek, Montgomery County, November 13, 1836, and is the second of nine children born to **Richard** and **Rebecca (Moore) Trotter**. The father was born October 20, 1810, and died May 14, 1876. He and wife were members of the Methodist Episcopal Church South, and he was a democrat. The mother was born October 26, 1812, and died May 3, 1882. Our subject was reared on a farm, and on December 16, 1857, was married to **Nancy E. Bunnell**. To them have been born seven children: **Martha E.**, born August 22, 1857; **Angie D.**, born December 24, 1858; **James F.**, born June 14, 1862; **George E.**, born January 22, 1865; **Charles W.**, born August 22, 1867; **Susan A.**, born October 25, 1871, and **Zalu**, born November 3, 1874, and died March 20, 1877. Our subject enlisted in the war in 1863, in the Tenth Tennessee Cavalry, C. S. A. He participated at Thompson's Station, and then returned home and was afterward taken to Clarksville, by the Eighty-third Illinois Regiment, and was imprisoned for six weeks. By taking the oath of allegiance, he was released and came home. He is a Democrat. His wife is a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church South.

ALBERT BONNELL

Among the representatives of the farming interests of Bureau county is Albert Bonnell, who was born in La Moille, August 1, 1856. His parents were Silas and Mary Ann (Smith) Bonnell.

The father, whose birth occurred in Bedford county, Pennsylvania. came to Bureau county in 1851, bringing with him his family. He had been married in 1842 to Miss Mary Ann Smith, also a native of Bedford county, and as the years passed, ten children were born unto them, of whom Albert is the seventh in order of birth. The father and three of the sons served in the Civil War, and only one returned, the others giving their lives in defense the Union cause upon the altar of their county.

Albert Bonnell, reared in the county of his nativity, is indebted to its public school system for the educational privileges he enjoyed in his boyhood and youth. He was early left fatherless, and in his minority his portion was largely that of hard and unremitting labor. After he attained man's estate he sought a companion and helpmate for life's journey, and was married to Miss Julia A. Craft, who was born in Stark county, Illinois, February 15, 1858, and died on the 10<sup>th</sup> of May, 1881. They became the parents of two children, of whom one died in infancy, while Mrs. Ida Ross still survives.

In order to provide for his family, Mr. Bonnell followed farming, and is now the owner of one hundred and fifty and a half acres of choice land, upon which are substantial buildings, standing in the midst of fine shade trees, which add to the value and beauty of the place. His farm comprises one of the fine locations of the county, and is attractive in its neat and thrifty appearance. Mr. Bonnell is now engaged in raising Poland China hogs, and also buys and feeds cattle, using the products of his fields in this way.

He votes with the Republican Party, and in religious faith is a Methodist, belonging to the church of that denomination in La Moille. Truly a self-made man, he gained his start in the business world by working by the month as a farm hand, and after making purchase of land he labored diligently and persistently, allowing no obstacle to bar his path if it could be overthrown by industry and determination. He is today one of the leading and prosperous farmers of the county, and is a man trusted and esteemed by friends and neighbors. He is assessor of his township at the present writing and has been school director for a number of years. The cause of education finds in him a warm and stalwart friend, and he withholds his support from no movement for the general good. He has ably fought life's battles and has come off victor in the strife, and today he possesses not only a good farming property, but also an honorable name, his record being in harmony with his professions as a member of the church.

#### SHANNON BONNELL

Shannon Bonnell, an active representative of the farming interests of La Moille township, is one of the native sons of Pennsylvania. He was born October 18, 1852, and the following year was brought to Illinois by his parents, Silas and Mary A. (Smith) Bonnell. The father was also a native of the Keystone state and in the middle of the nineteenth century brought his family to Illinois. There were nine children, of whom Shannon was the fourth in order of birth.

Mr. Bonnell of this review was reared to the occupation of the farm, early becoming familiar with the duties and labors that devolve upon the agriculturist as he tills his fields and harvests his crops. When not working at the plow or in the cultivation of the fields, Mr. Bonnell was largely engaged in the pursuit of education, being a student in the district schools near his father's home. As he neared man's estate he began thinking of establishing a home of his own, and as a companion and helpmate for life's journey he chose Miss Tena Maloy, who was born in Bartholomew county, Indiana, December 31, 1856, and who gave him her hand in marriage in Bureau county on the 11<sup>th</sup> of March, 1876. Her parents were John and Laner (Shroyer) Maloy, the former a native of Ohio and the latter of Pennsylvania. In their family were seven children, five of whom are still living, Mrs. Bonnell being the eldest. Our subject and his wife have three

children: Everett S., born October 20, 1877; John H., January 11, 1879; and Elva A., born December 11, 1883.

The family home stands upon a farm of forty acres of fine land which is very rich and productive and which responds readily to the care and labor bestowed upon it. Here Mr. Bonnell is engaged in raising hogs, sheep and cattle, and his annual sales of stock bring him several hundred dollars. He is a man of keen discrimination in his business affairs, and all that he possesses has been acquired through his own labor. Both he and his wife are members of the Mystic Workers at La Moille, and in his political connection he is a republican. Mr. and Mrs. Bonnell also hold membership in the Baptist church, and are people of genuine personal worth, whose lives are characterized by many good deeds and kindly actions. Their neighbors attest their integrity and speak in terms of praise of their many good qualities, and the life record of Mr. Bonnell, with its successes, is another proof of the old adage that honesty is the best policy.



### GET OUT WHENEVER POSSIBLE

I've just read Maureen Taylor's article on the importance of getting out and using libraries, genealogy archives and other sources beyond the computer. Several years ago, my husband and I were in a small research facility in northeast Pennsylvania. We were not having a great deal of luck, so I wandered over to a table where a number of books were stacked. I fanned through several (always looking in the index for names and places by the way). Inside the back cover of one book, I found a fold-out map showing early roads and settlers in the area following the Revolutionary War. To our delight, the locations of home sites of two of our families were identified, along with other helpful notes. We were fortunate to be able to obtain a copy of the map. Finally, I must say that I do not believe that this map had ever before been opened up; in fact the book appeared to have been unread! We have found similar small but helpful bits of information in other research facilities over the years.

The bottom line is you have to get out even though you may not be able to do it very often. The breakthroughs seem to come in bits and pieces from these sources. It's also essential to talk with researchers, librarians and archivists in these places. Quite often, you'll find their memory jogged by your questions and comments.
